

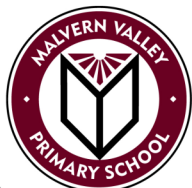

REFERRALS FOR SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST SUPPORT:

The Department of Education has completed a review of the delivery of psychology, speech therapy and social workers across the state and will be introducing a new process for accessing this support.

School's will need to put a referral on-line and a team leader for a Network of Schools, will prioritize the request across the network. There are 27 schools in our network. While a school will usually get the same worker, this will not always be the case as there may be someone with specialist skills who may be better equipped to deal with the need so they will be given the case.

More information regarding this new process will be provided as the new process gets going.
